

Florida Quail Hunting: Hunting Game Redefined

If you are a bird hunting enthusiast you might be aware that the Florida quail hunting season for this year is underway. This piece of info could get Quail hunting buffs excited, and even the newbie hunters will find this season to be an inviting one, especially if this is their first real hunting expedition. Given that as most other hunting sports, quail hunting is also strictly regulated so as to allow the population of quail to remain stable, and hence the idea of controlled hunting times. This means that the Florida quail hunting season is fixed for a period of 2 to 3 months, with clear rules on bird hunting, the number of birds permitted for each hunting day, and the weapons that are acceptable. The wildlife conservation groups which provide guidelines to quail hunting also offer useful advice to ensure hunter safety and stipulate that each hunter carries a valid quail hunting license. Novice hunters can participate in the ongoing Florida quail hunting season as long as they are in possession of a valid hunting license, while residents of the state can even look at acquiring annual licenses or an extended validity 5 year hunting license.

In the United States quail hunting is considered a stress free sport that provides ample opportunity to socialize with fellow hunters. The hunting itself happens in wide open spaces and fields, or privately owned forest land, which means that the hunters take relaxed strolls across wide areas thus finding time to interact with fellow hunters. But with this comes the disadvantage of distraction, since the hunter is prone to get sidetracked when they need to be alert, and this is especially true for novice hunters who must concentrate before shooting. For this reason, all hunters must wear bright hued vests and hats in fluorescent orange, since this is easily seen even from a distance be it open fields or dense forest land. Also the hunting group comprises pointing dogs and retrievers, which aid in alerting hunters of potential prey, and one needs to make certain of their safety as well. Since dogs tend to scamper around unpredictably, ground level shooting is best avoided and this means that quail that fly too close to the ground are not to be aimed.

Florida quail hunting is undeniably a popular sport since it provides a good platform for even newbie hunters to try their hand at shooting game. Most hunting groups include seasoned hands and a newbie hunter may discover priceless tips on being alert to potential prey and successful shooting. Hunting clubs also offer seasoned hunting guides and dogs to watch for and flush the quail out into the open. Since Florida quail hunting does not require specific hunting equipment, even those hunters with smaller shotguns can opt for a hunting session. Indeed heavier guns could prove cumbersome since most quail hunting expeditions involve walking across expanses of fields or farmland.

So go for the rush of adrenaline, have some fun bird hunting and take home a distinctive souvenir!
